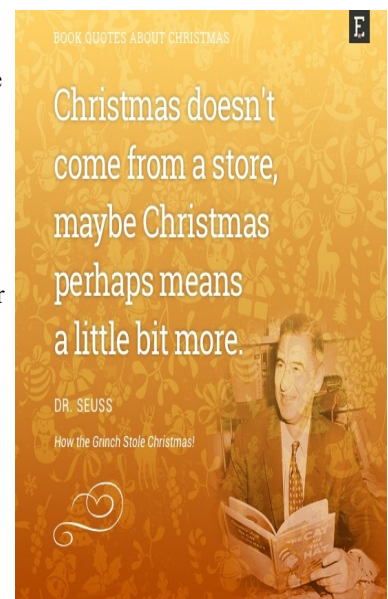

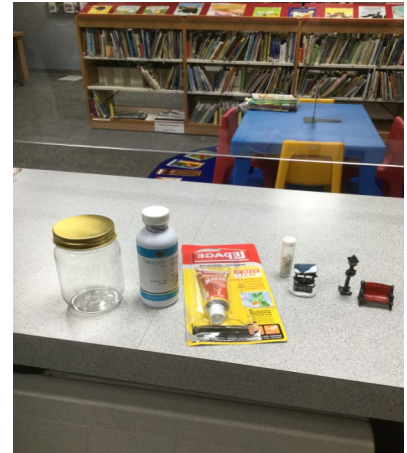
Snow Globe Instructions



Materials:

- Glass or plastic jar with tight-fitting lid
- Water (enough to fill jar almost full)
- Glycerin (approx. 1 tsp.— add more if sparkles fall too quickly) Can be found in drugstores.
- Aquarium glue or Epoxy glue. (I preferred aquarium glue as it had an easier, faster application. I bought the glue at Home Hardware)
- Glitter or actual snow globe snow (if you can find it!)
- A plastic or ceramic decoration that can be immersed in water.
- Small piece of sandpaper

Instructions:

Lightly sand the inside of the lid to receive the glue

Before gluing, plan out where you will place the ornament on the lid keeping it away from the outer edges of the lid. (Or jar will not close properly)

Place the glue on the bottom of your ornament and attach it to the inside of the jar lid.

Wait for 45 minutes or longer to make sure the glue has dried completely Be sure to follow glue safety guidelines and drying times. **WARNING—DO NOT LET SMALL CHILDREN COME IN CONTACT WITH THE GLUE.**

Fill the jar almost to the top with water and add the glycerin. If you add too much glycerin, the glitter will clump on the bottom.

Add glitter or snow to the water. Screw the lid on your jar and shake it gently to mix the glycerin and water. ENJOY!
